Visit the Manheim Community Library. Passes will be checked out on your valid Library System of Lancaster County Library Card. Passes can be checked out for 7 days. Renewals are possible if no one else is waiting. Waiting Lists are kept for each pass. Though you may not specify dates, you may place your name on the waiting list for the museum of your choice at www.manheimlibrary.com. Follow the "Your Account" link.
