In 1985, Oasis formed as a ministry to provide the community of Manheim with a youth center and youth programs. Oasis quickly became a favorite place for many teens to hang out and receive the relational, social, mental, and spiritual help that they so desperately needed. With its humble beginnings in the town's Union Hall, Oasis eventually moved to a grander facility along Railroad Avenue. For about 17 years the ministry operated out of this location and eventually involved

nearly 100 youth each week.
