## NEW BUSINESS: SKATE-IT

A new business has rolled into the Greentree Business Park. Skate-It, the county's only indoor skate park.

While skateboarding has its limits to the outdoors, it will not be an issue with this new venture of Eric Anderson. Inspired by his two sons, Eric decided to create a facility for skaters to enjoy

The 7,000 square foot facility located at 253 Redwood Lane, Manheim, will have a 1,000 square foot retail area and 6,000 square foot skate area.

Obstacles will include a mini-ramp (half pipe) that's six feet high and 40 feet wide, and a seven foot speed ramp, with a 45 degree slope that allows skaters to accelerate.

Hours of operation are weekdays 4 to 9pm, Saturdays 2 to 10pm and Sundays 1 to 9pm. Admission will be \$10 to \$12 for sessions of two to three hours, or \$20 for all day Saturday and Sunday.
